

Terry Kling

- Terry was the finest third baseman in the league for years
- Suffering many injuries Terry never shied from putting himself in front of any ground ball or line drive while playing third base, the second most dangerous position (behind pitcher) on a softball field
- During some years Terry led his Bubbs, and later Palmers teams, in batting average, becoming well known for his ability to hit to the opposite field
- Terry could, at times, display deceptive power in his hitting
- It would be difficult to find a more friendly player than Terry, who in his cut-off sleeved shirts, went around the ball park talking to almost anyone he encountered
- Terry played on numerous league and league tournament championship teams for Bubbs and Palmers and was also in demand for travel ball
